

REGULAR MEETING, TOWN OF LIVONIA

February 21, 2013

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Livonia, County of Livingston and the State of New York was held at Livonia Town Hall, 35 Commercial Street, Livonia on February 21, 2013.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gott at 7:00 PM.
Doug Grouse led the pledge.

PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

Supervisor Gott opened the floor for Open Session but no one wished to make any comments.

RESOLUTION 31-2013

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES FROM 2/7/2013

On motion of Councilmember Grouse seconded by Councilmember English the following resolution was

Resolved to approve the meeting minutes from February 7, 2013.

DISCUSS DRUG AND ALCOHOL COUNSELING

Supervisor Gott reported that Dave Bernacki owns a company called Safe Driver Solutions. They do drug and alcohol testing. Several towns in the county use their services, and Supervisor Gott would like the town board to consider engaging them as well.

Currently, when it is someone's turn to be tested, they must be driven to Mt. Morris and back for the test. In addition to mileage, this costs man hours for two employees to and from the facility. Safe Driver Solutions' prices are in line with what we are currently paying, and the test is performed on site. The cost for the DOT test is \$56 per person, and the non-DOT test is \$50 per person.

Like our current system, the testing is completely random. They guarantee that everyone will be tested at least once a year. Because it is on site, there is less chance that someone could drink something beforehand that would cover drug use.

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Supervisor Gott has not discussed this with Highway Superintendent Dave Coty, as he feels this is a town board decision.

Supervisor Gott reported that the committee will be interviewing candidates for the Court Clerk position next Thursday. There were over forty applicants and they will be interviewing seven. Hopefully the committee will have a recommendation for appointment at the next meeting.
