RESOLUTION 83-2017

AUTHORIZE SUPERVISOR TO SIGN A HOME RULE REQUEST FOR ENACTMENT OF A SPECIAL LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF THE JACK EVANS COMMUNITY CENTER

Supervisor Gott explained that he received a call from Cathy Young's office to inform him that the Assembly wanted to make slight changes to the wording of the Home Rule Bill regarding the sale of the Jack Evans Community Center. Because of the changes, the paperwork needs to be submitted again with the new bill numbers on them.

On motion of Councilmember Grouse seconded by Councilmember English the following resolution was

ADOPTED Ayes - 3 (Gott, English, Grouse)
Nays - 0

Resolved to authorize Supervisor Gott to sign a Home Rule Request for Enactment of a Special Law (Senate bill # S.6698 and Assembly bill # A.8417) to allow the Town to sell the Jack Evans Community Center to the Little Lakes Community Association, Inc. for adequate consideration with the understanding that it be used for community use.

With no further business, on a motion of Councilmember Grouse seconded by Councilmember English the meeting was adjourned at 5:16 AM. Carried unanimously.
