

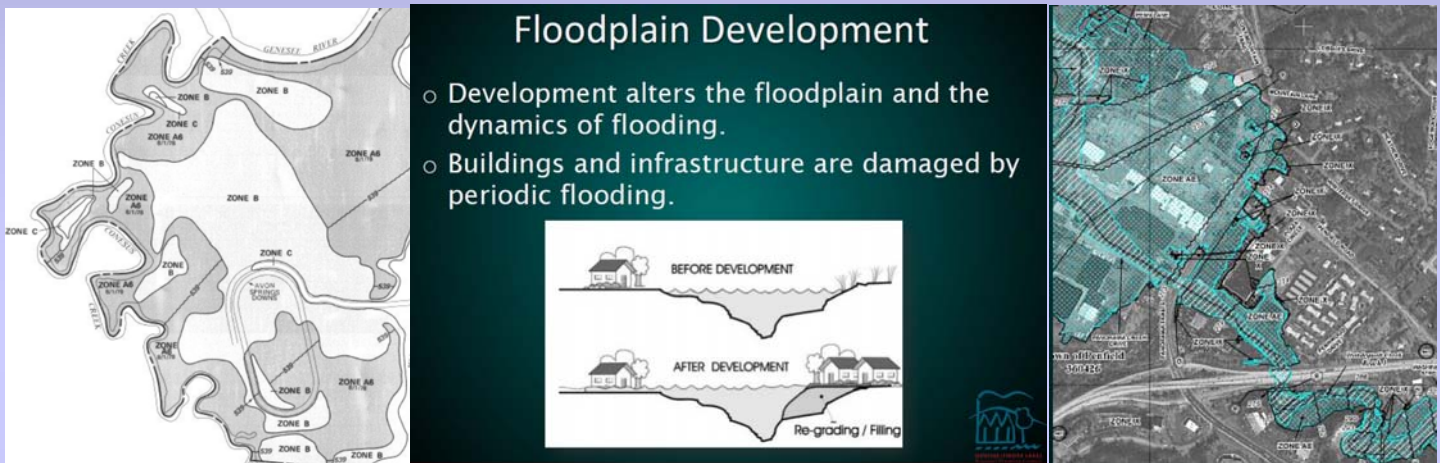

NFIP provides the maps and regulatory basis for local floodplain management. It is the primary source of insurance protection for floodprone properties. Its success depends on the people responsible for administering its mapping, regulatory and insurance aspects.
