Board of Trustees Meeting

January 23rd, 2025

Present: Mayor Chris Genthner, Cindy Pfeifer, Colleen Hay, Dan Coon, Bill Kurtz, Holly Kubrich, and Chris Hoffmann.

Mayor Chris Genthner called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

M/2/C (B. Kurtz, D. Coon) to approve the minutes from the December 18^{th} , 2024 meeting. Passed 4 to 0. Holly Kubrich asked if Chris West has notified the current tenant at 22 - 24 Commercial Street of the proposed renovation. Mayor Genthner replied yes.

M/2/C (H. Kubrich, D. Coon) to approve the payment of claims #198 to #223 in the amount of \$32,272.91. Passed 4 to 0. Claim # 214, payable to American Rock Salt Company, LLC, indicates that currently the Village's supply of road salt is OK.

Oath of Office - Colleen Hay.

The Oath of Office was administered by Cindy Pfeifer. Colleen Hay recited the Oath of Office declaration. The book was signed and notarized. Congratulations were extended to Colleen.

Lease Agreement with Rotary – 1st Read

Please find this one page item, titled License Agreement, attached.

This agreement, between the Village of Livonia and the Rotary Club of Livonia, states that the Livonia Rotary will purchase and build a storage shed for medical equipment. This service will be called the "Loan Closet." The Loan Closet will be

located on property owned by the Village of Livonia, at 36 Commercial Street. Village of Livonia Attorney Peter Skivington has reviewed and approved this Agreement. Dan Coon mentioned that building the shed is "on hold" during the cold weather. Insurance for this structure will be covered by the Village of Livonia. Dan Coon will present this Agreement at the next Rotary meeting.

Budget Transfer Discussion

Chris Hoffmann asked the Village Board to consider transferring \$40,000 from the Equipment Reserve Fund to the Equipment Fund to be able to purchase a tractor with an attached salter. Please find this Resolution attached.

Discussion: William Kurtz Farmland Protection Project

Bill Kurtz handed out a map showing his farmland. 41 acres are within Village boundaries. Bill would like to protect his land and keep it available for farming. Please find attached William Kurtz's Farm map and a letter from Genesee Valley Conservancy. The letter from the Conservancy states that they will not protect farmland within a Village, except when the Village municipality endorses the project with either a resolution or a letter of support provided by either the Village of Livonia Board or the Livonia Planning Board. Future development on the 41 acres would be limited to agricultural use. Mayor Genthner asked if Bill's family is aware of this protection project. Bill replied that they were. He also mentioned that when he retires he will rent the land to another farmer. This subject will be discussed again at the February meeting.

- 2. The purpose of the storage unit will be for the storage of medical equipment that the Livonia Rotary Club provides to the residents of the Town and Village of Livonia at no cost.
- 3. By this Agreement, the Village hereby provides to the Livonia Rotary Club the license to locate the building on Village property for only that purpose stated herein.
- 4. The Village provides the license to the Livonia Rotary Club for an indefinite period of time, subject to termination by the Village of Livonia or the Livonia Rotary Club upon six (6) months written notice.
- 5. Upon termination, the Livonia Rotary Club will either remove the structure or surrender the structure to the Village of Livonia.

ONLINE SERVICE AUTHORIZATION WITH FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF OMAHA

RESOLVED, that the Organization authorizes use of the Online Services (the Services) in connection with its accounts at First National Bank Omaha;


FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Organization agrees to the terms of the Online Service Agreement with Bank (specifically including, but not limited to, the terms of Section 2 thereof pertaining to User IDs, Passwords and Security) (the Agreement) and hereby authorizes any officer or representative of the Organization to execute such application, agreements and other documents, including revisions thereto, as may be necessary or appropriate in the opinion of such officer or representative to obtain the Services and to bind the Organization to the Agreement;

FURTHER RESOLVED, any representative of the Organization with present or future authority to open additional accounts in the name of the Organization (the Master Agent) is authorized to appoint from time to time the Administrator referred to in the Agreement, it being understood that (1) the Administrator will have the ability to add, delete, and modify User IDs and passwords and to determine the persons that will have access thereto and the type of access they have; and (2) any one person in possession of a User ID and password will be permitted to use the Services, which may include the making of payments from the accounts of the Organization, regardless of whether such person is an authorized signer on the Organizations accounts, and regardless of whether any such accounts otherwise require two or more signatures or have other restrictions. The Bank may accept appointments of the Administrator orally, but is entitled to require written confirmation thereof. Upon acceptance of such an appointment, the Bank may so note on this form or on any other similar or related forms pertaining to the Organization's accounts at the Bank;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Bank shall be under no obligation to make any inquiries in order to verify or confirm: (1) any representations on instructions of any Master Agent; (2) instructions received from the Administrator; (3) any transactions effected through the use of the Organization's User IDs or passwords; or (4) the application of the Organization's funds, it being understood that the Bank shall in no way be responsible for misapplication of the Organization's fund by virtue of the authority herein given;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the power and authority granted by these resolutions shall continue in full force and effect until notice in writing is received by the Bank of the cancellation or modification thereof. Such notification must specifically state that it relates to Online Services, describe the termination or change requested, and be delivered to the Bank in a time and manner that affords the Bank a reasonable time to act thereon; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that to the extent these resolutions are inconsistent with any prior resolutions of the Organization, these resolutions shall control. These resolutions shall further control over any future resolutions pertaining to the Organization's deposit accounts at Bank, if a Master Agent instructs the Bank to include such accounts in the Services.

Dear Mayor Genthner,

The Genesee Valley Conservancy has been communicating with a Village of Livonia resident, William Kurtz, who is interested in protecting his land and keeping it available for farmers. With 93 acres of 100% prime soils, this would be great farmland to remain in agricultural production and dissuade any conversion of land to uses that are incompatible with farming.


The tax parcels that would be included in a farmland protection project are visible on the attached map. Our concerns are the 41-acre and 0.6-acre westerly parcels that are within Village boundaries (notated by the pink boundary lines). It is our Acquisitions Policy that we will not protect farmland within a Village, "except when the Village municipality has endorsed the project via a resolution or letter of support provided by either the Village board or planning board, whichever entity the municipality determines should review the potential project."

If we receive such support, we can move forward with an application to protect Mr. Kurtz' land using a conservation easement. However, as Bill Kurtz is a Village Trustee, he would need to be recused from any meeting or discussion on this matter, not merely abstain.

We are inquiring to see if the Village is willing to allow this farmland to be permanently protected, acknowledging that future development on the 41-acre parcel within the Village boundary would be limited to purposes that are consistent with agricultural uses. If it would help, Genesee Valley Conservancy staff would be happy to attend a future village board meeting to discuss our Farmland Protection programs in more detail.




