**Board of Trustees Meeting**  
**April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2024**

Present: Deputy Mayor Bill Kurtz, Dan Coon, Rhonda Roeser, Chris Hoffmann, Cindy Pfeifer, Annette Meade and Holly Kubrich.

Deputy Mayor Bill Kurtz called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

Open Session – Public Hearing for the adoption of Proposed 2024 – 2025 Budget. M/2/C (D. Coon, H. Kubrich) to open the Public Hearing for the 2024 to 2025 Budget. Passed 4 to 0.

M/2/C (A. Meade, D. Coon) to approve the minutes from the April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2024 meeting. Passed 4 to 0. There were no comments.

M/2/C (D. Coon, A. Meade) to approve the payment of claims #290 to #297 in the amount of \$73,658.85. Passed 4 to 0. There was a short discussion about claim #292, made payable to the Livingston County Treasurer in the amount of \$900.00. This payment is for the recent Village Election of a Trustee.

2024 – 2025 Budget Discussion and potential passage.

There have been no changes made to the Proposed Budget and there were no Village Residents in attendance of this hearing.

Website proposal from the Town of Livonia – Cindy Pfeifer.

Cindy Pfeifer is the Village Website Administrator. She informed the Board that the Town of Livonia is having problems and is considering switching to a different Website. The Village and the Town of Livonia currently share the same Website.
